The REACH programme is provided as part of the Department of Education's 'Emotional Health and Well-being Framework in Education'. REACH is a dedicated youth work programme which supports schools across Northern Ireland to improve emotional health and well-being outcomes for pupils, whilst also providing support for teachers and parents.

REACH is delivered within the school environment by a professionally qualified youth work team and provides programmes based on the needs of pupils and schools under the themes of; Wellbeing for All, Early Support and Enhanced Support. The programme will be delivered to our P6 pupils for 5 weeks starting on Wednesday 18th January and ending on 22nd February.
